Preoperative exams:

A blood test (complete blood count, coagulation, HIV test, and hepatitis serology) and an EKG are required for the operation.

We are happy to refer you to a laboratory or you can have these tests carried out by your family doctor or internist (tests must be done no more than 3 weeks prior to the operation).

Preparing for surgery at home:

Begin the Octenisan Set preoperative cleansing process 5 days prior to surgery.

Please note:

Do not shave the skin around the area to be operated on for 10 days before the operation. Shaving can cause minor skin injuries, which can be a contraindication for surgery.

On the scheduled day of operation, you will be admitted to Confraternität Private Hospital.

- Athletic shoes for physical therapy
